



# Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS-2) Training Course

The Autism Diagnostic Observation Scale-Second Edition (ADOS-2) is a standardised assessment of the social, play and communication skills of individuals who may be on the autism spectrum. It is considered a gold standard assessment tool in the diagnosis of autism.

## What does the ADOS-2 course cover?

- Introduction to the administration and coding of the ADOS-2 Modules 1-4.
- Opportunities to watch videos and code administration of the ADOS Modules 1-4.
- Practical use of the ADOS with a volunteer and individual feedback.
- Discussion of the application and interpretation of the ADOS-2 and how it relates to autism diagnostic assessment.

Trainees should come away from the training confident to develop their fluency in the use of the ADOS-2 in their clinical setting.

## Who can attend?

The course is open to Speech Pathologists, Clinical Psychologists, Registered Psychologists, Psychiatrists and Paediatricians. Previous experience working with autistic individuals and their families is required.

## Course format

The course will run **in person** at CliniKids Joondalup. Participants must attend all four days of training to receive their course certificate.

## Cost?

The cost of the course is \$2000 and is payable in full prior to the first day of training. There is an additional \$500 fee if you are seeking supervision to reach research reliability.
